UN's city definition • Definition of "city proper" mainly based on administrative boundaries, often excluding suburban areas • Two or more separately administered neighbouring cities may in reality form a single urbanized entity • The administrative boundaries of some cities may include agricultural land

DEFINITION OF "URBAN" - United Nations

The answer is, there is no universally accepted definition of a smart city. It means different things to different people. The conceptualisation of Smart City, therefore, varies from city to city and country to country, depending on the level of development, willingness to change and reform, resources and aspirations of the city residents.

What is Smart City - Smart Cities Mission

A city with suburbs was a city surrounded with open pasture-grounds, such as the forty-eight cities which were given to the Levites (Numbers 35:2-7). There were six cities of refuge, three on each side of Jordan, namely, Kadesh, Shechem, Hebron, on the west of Jordan; and on the east, Bezer, Ramoth-gilead, and Golan.
